


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A college education is an important investment in your future. New Jersey City University is dedicated to helping make quality education a ordable.

In addition to providing referrals for o campus specialists and other resources as needed, HWC's sta educates students on ways to improve their health and self-advocacy in the future as informed consumers of healthcare services. Students can now access the Student Health Services Pyramed Portal by logging into GothicNet using their login credentials. On the landing Student Homepage, students can view the 'My Tasks' tile to check if they have any immunization holds. Students may click the 'My Task' tile to connect to the Student Health Services Pyramed Portal to upload any pending documentation to be submitted. A confirmation notification will be sent to the student once the document(s) have been reviewed and approved. The immunization hold will also be removed from the student's account once the pending documents' requirement is fulfilled.


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The purpose of Student Government is to serve the student body and act as a liaison between the students, faculty and stall of the university.
