



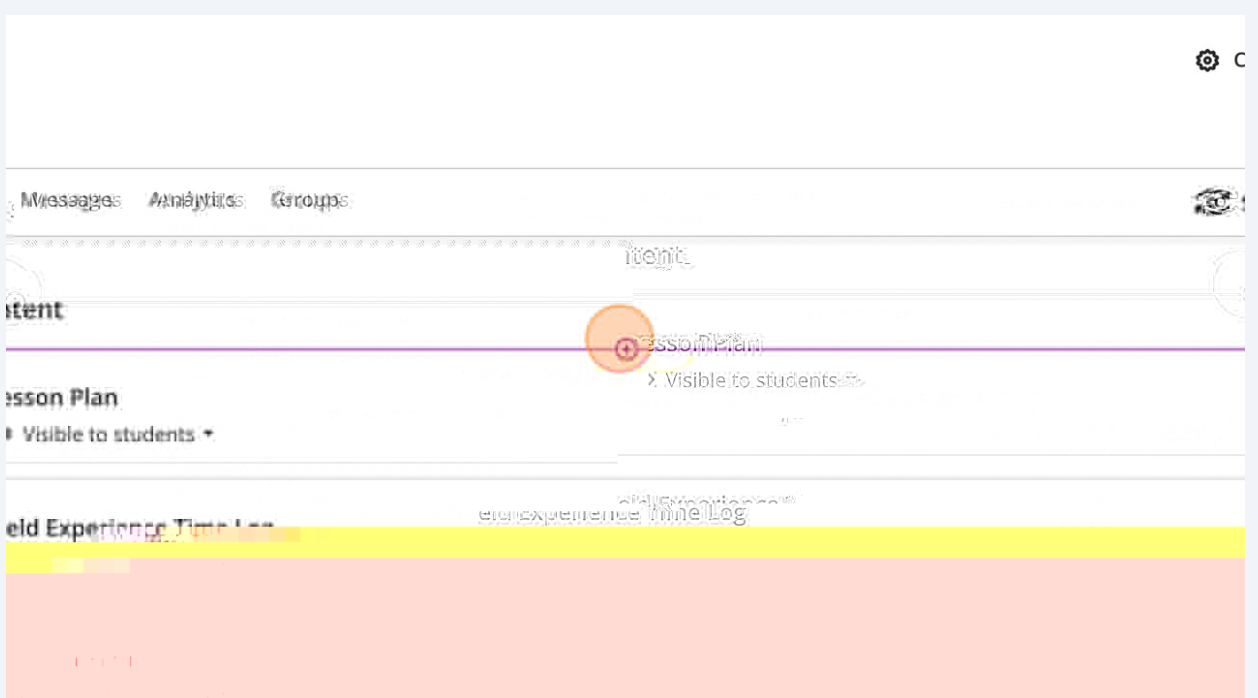
Candidate Disposition Inventory in Portfolio

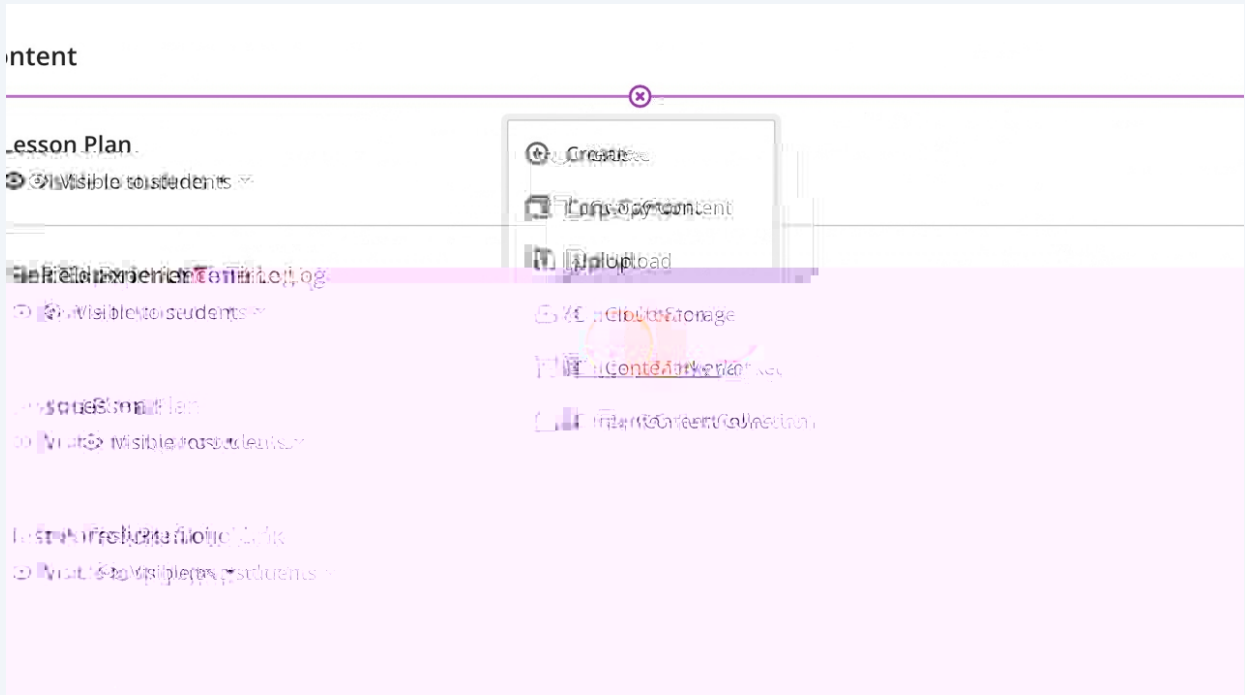

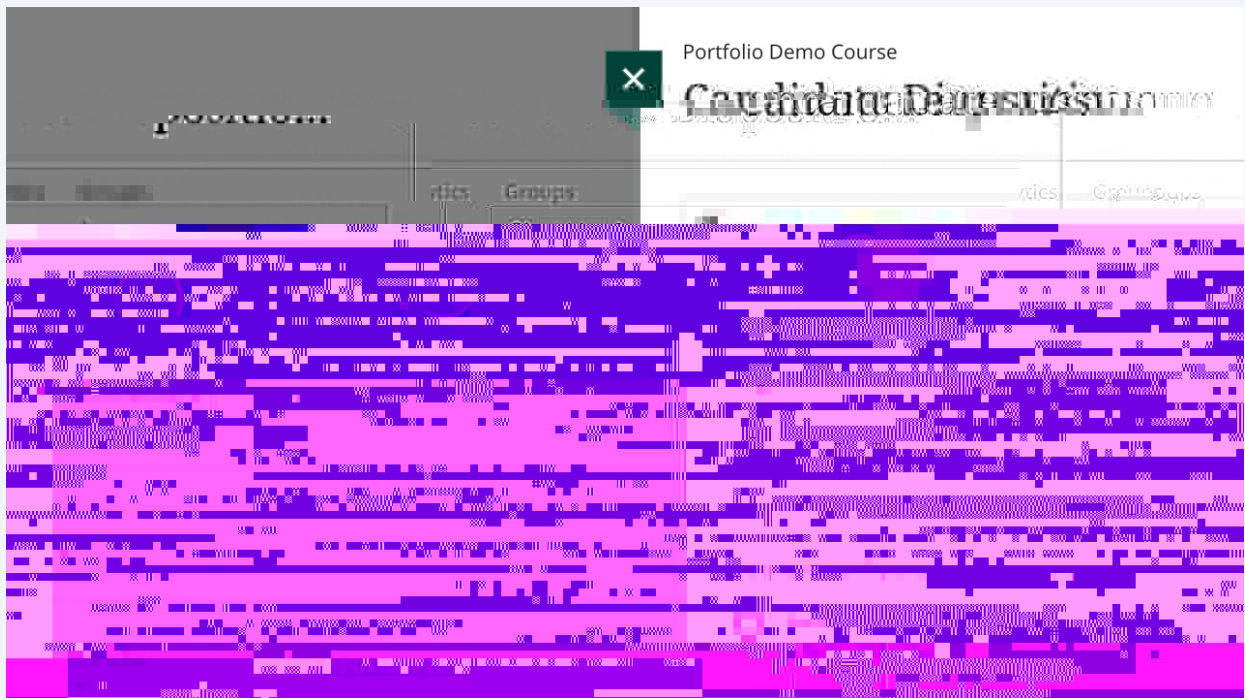
5 Use the menu at the right of the link you just create to select "Edit"



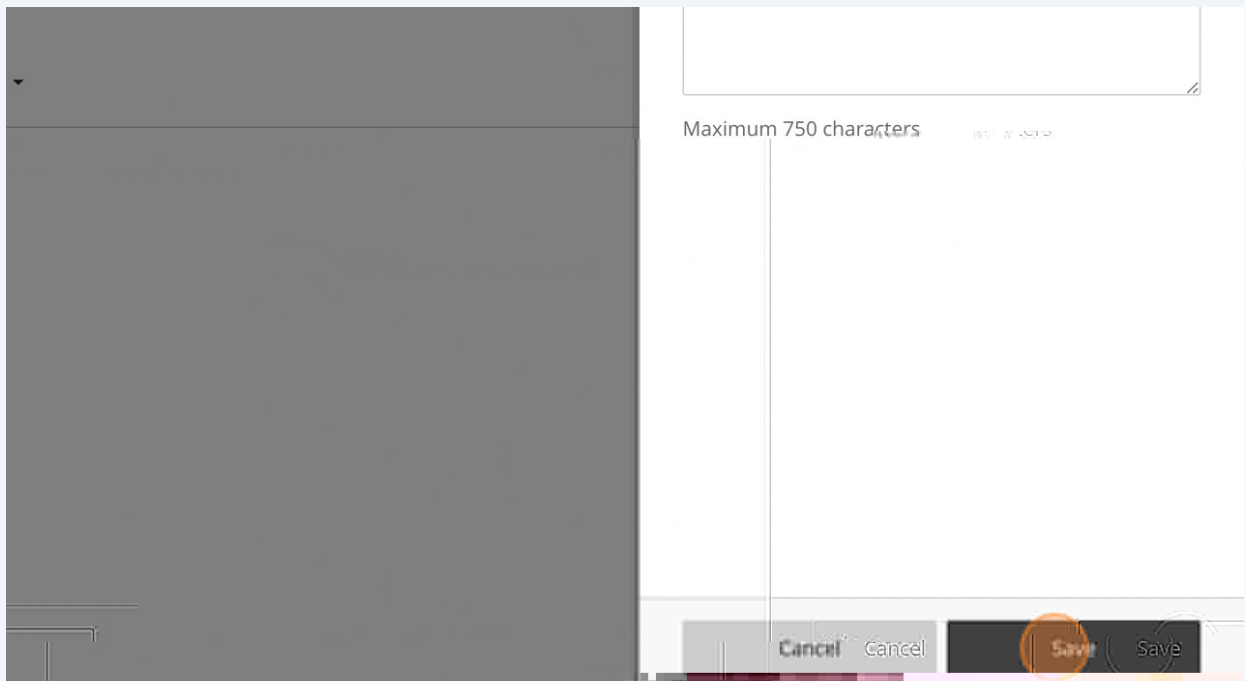
6 Double-click to change the link name to whatever you prefer.



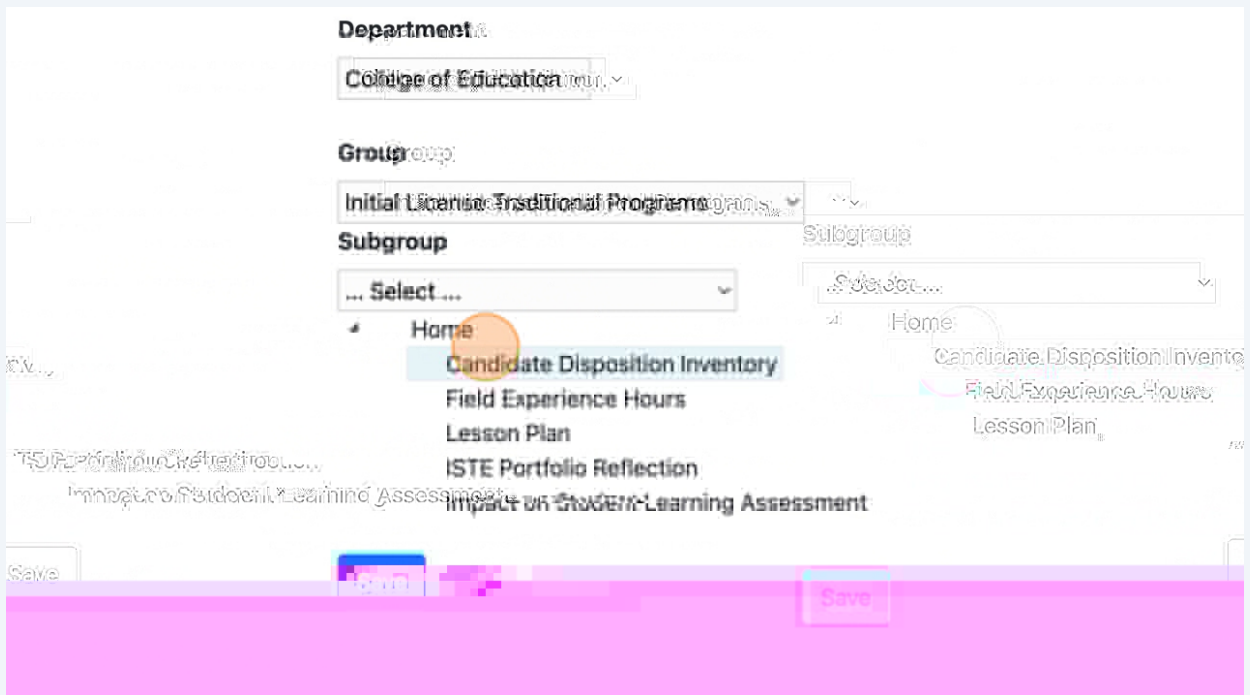
7 Click "Visible to students"



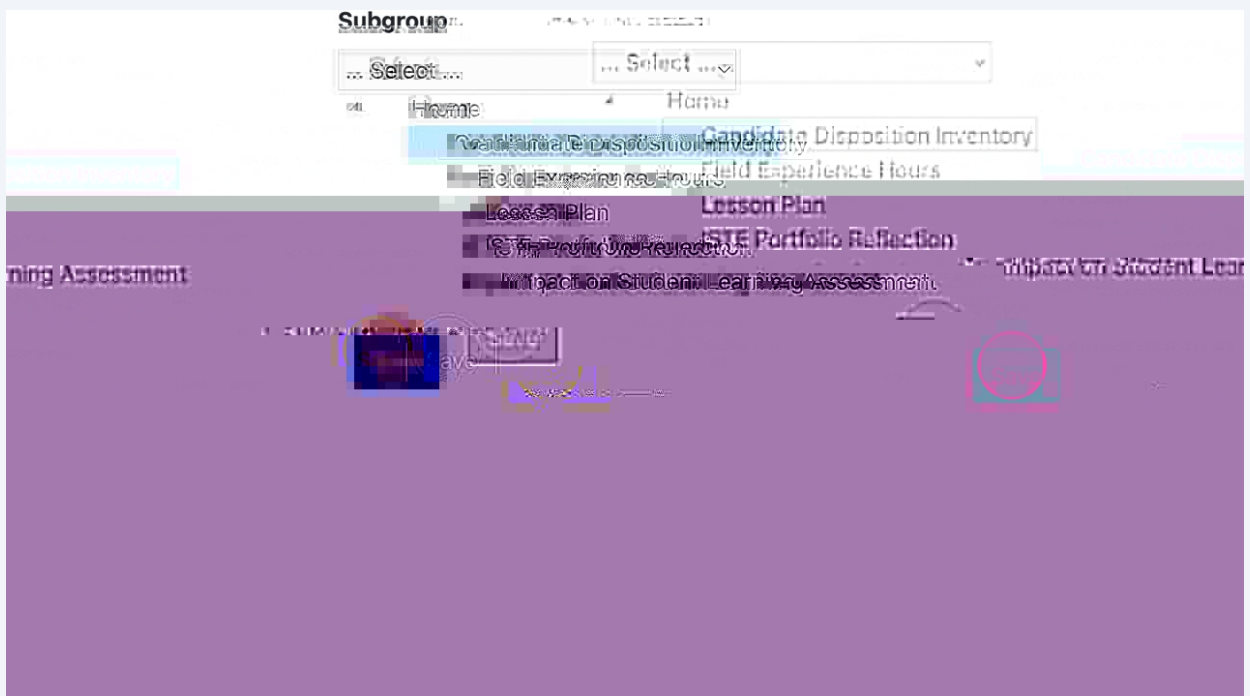
8 Click "Save" when you have finished your edits.

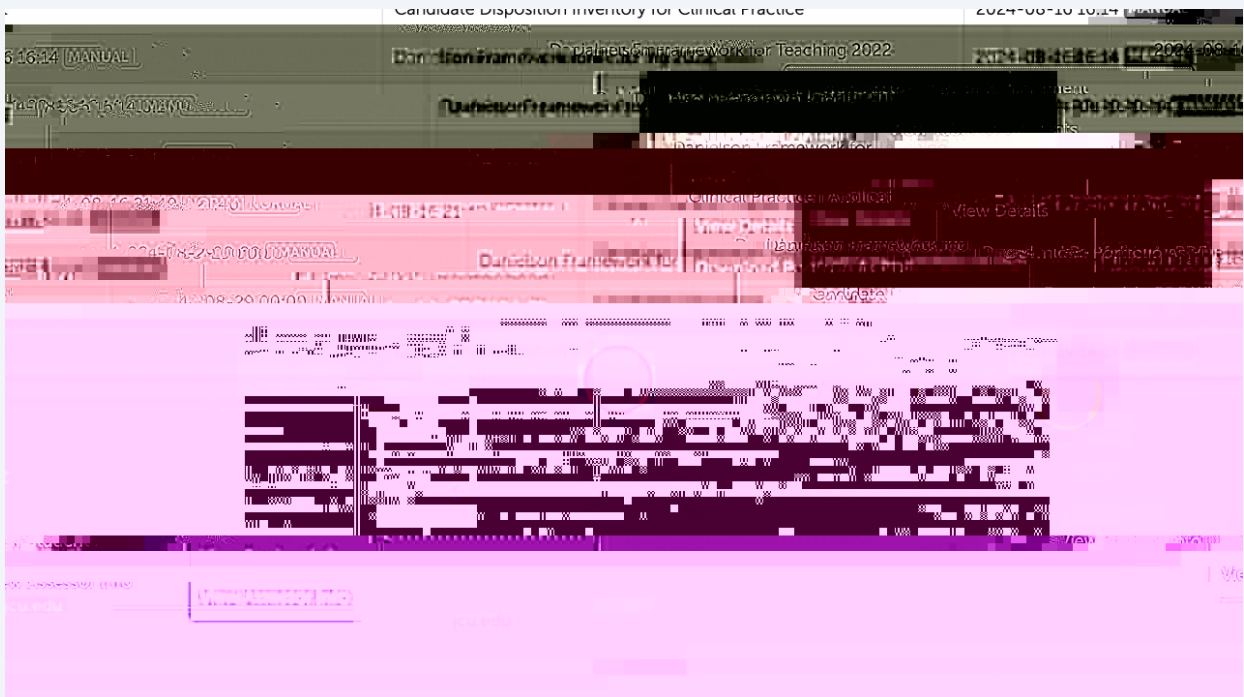

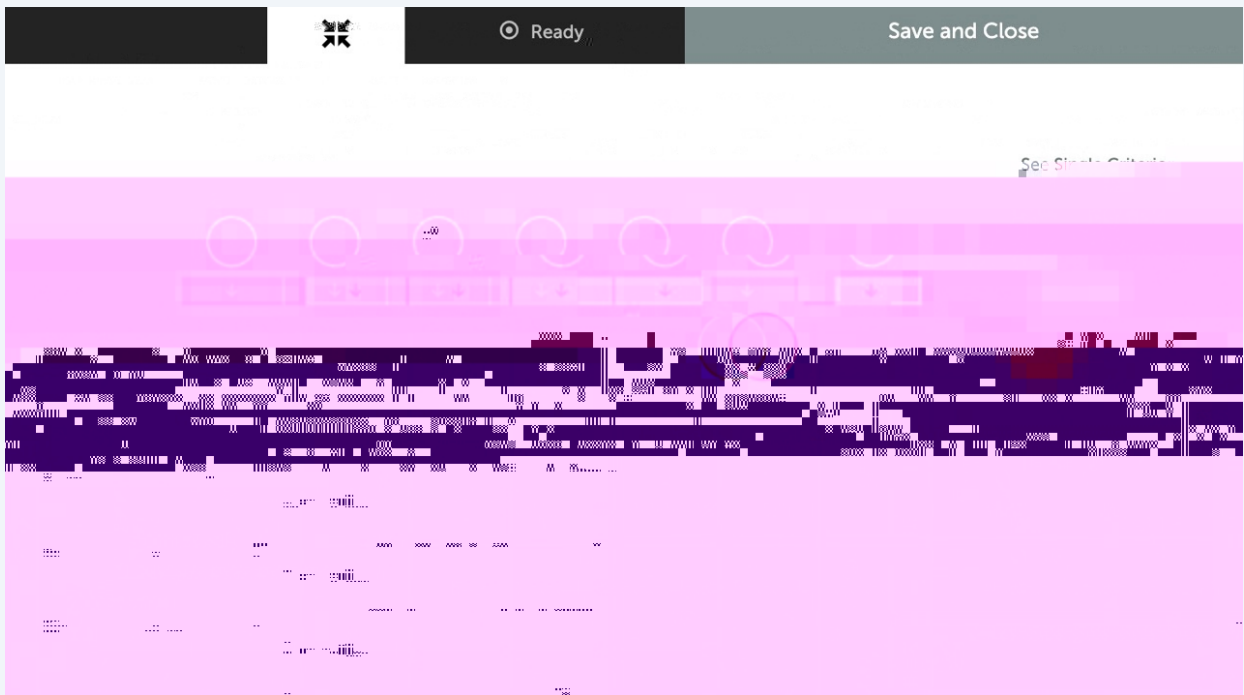

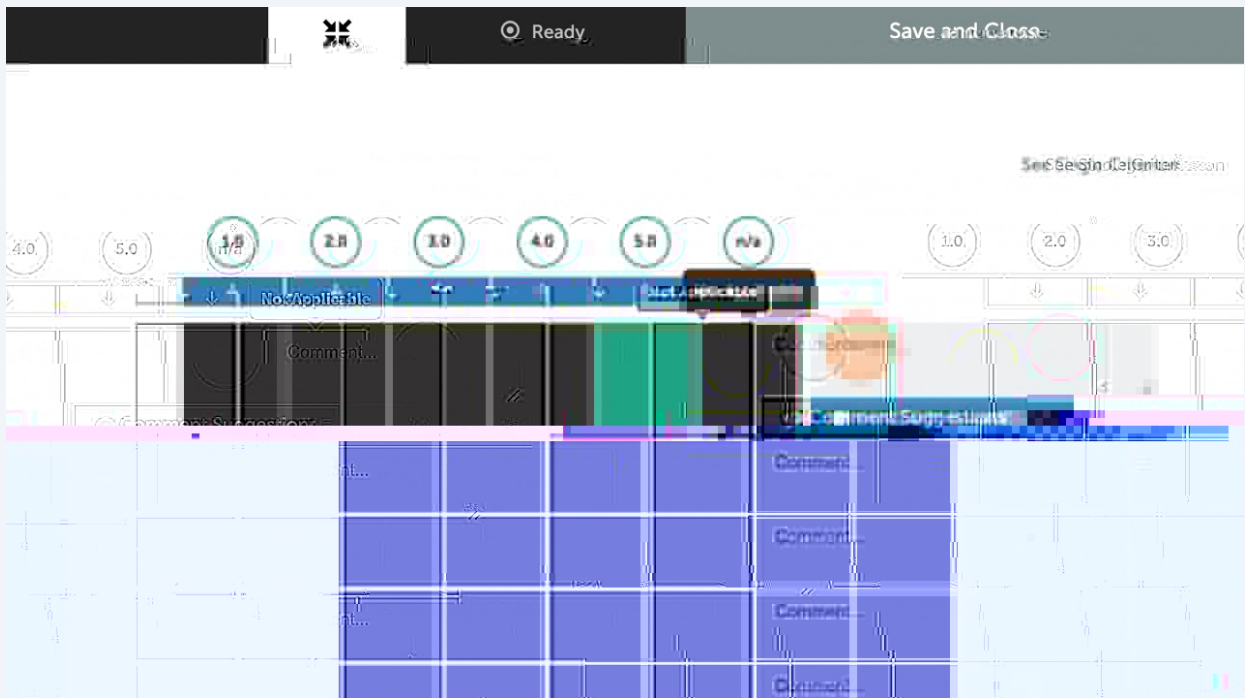
5 Select "Assess"



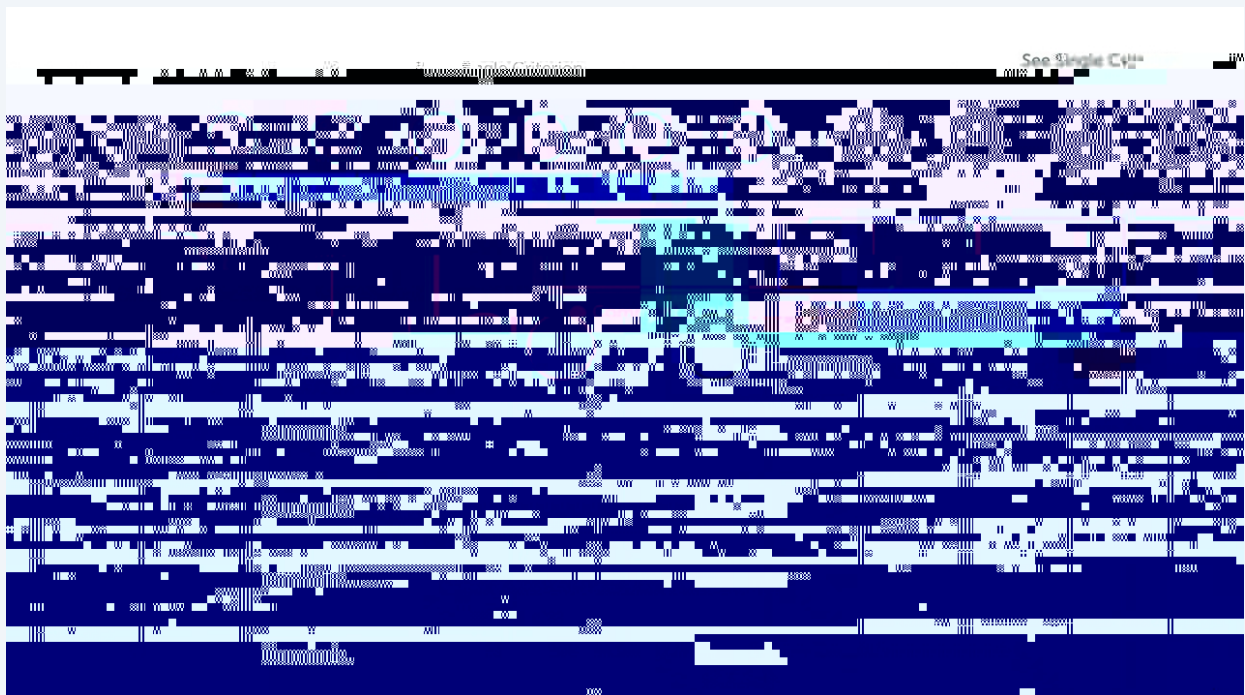
6 Begin assessing the student by clicking the boxes for the scoring rubric.
